Support for the clinics

- Our clinics Crossroads, Phumlani, Macincedane and Brown's Farm still receive their weekly bread, sandwiches, fruit and boiled eggs.
- 2 Bakkie loads of winter goods were distributed as part of the 2017 Winter Drive.
- Each of the clinics received 45 5ltr bottles of water kindly donated as part of the drought relief.
- Macincedane and Crossroads were provided with foodstuffs for the patients attending their Aids Day functions.
- Crossroads received foodstuff for the patients and staff attending the Nurses Day celebration.
- Crossroads received 50 food parcels and 50 blankets, these were given to the patients on Mandela Day.
- 100 blankets were donated to the O.W.L shelter in Landsdowne. A special thank you to Kira Coetzee who is 11 years old and raised all the money to buy the blankets.
- 120 Food hampers were distributed to Macincedane and Crossroads for the Xmas drive.
- 200 wrapped children's toys were given to Macincedane in December. A special thank you to the Brave Foundation.

Stormont School Primary School, Nyanga:

- 18 children were sponsored to attend the Grade 7 graduation camp in December 2017. Meals and treats were provided for the entire class.
- Food was provided for 106 learners attending a regional interschool choir contest.
- 100 learners were provided with lunch and snacks during Sports Day.
- The school received 500 "goody bags" as part of the Xmas drive.
- The Outreach continues to support the school providing weekly sandwiches.
